| Electricity and Cabling | Operator, spectator, participants | Injury to operator, spectators or participants due to tripping.  Electric shock                                   | Medium | Item requires access to 13 amp plug socket. Power source should be no more that 25m away from equipment. All cabling to be covered where required and routed away from walkways etc. All electrical components to be regularly checked and covered by a PAT test.                      | Low | Yes |

| Flying<br>Objects       | Staff, participants, spectators   | If the game involves throwing, there is a risk of injury from being struck by a flying object as part of the game | Medium | Game objects, such as balls and darts etc should only be thrown within the stall area and in the direction of the target. Only JM staff, or named responsible adult are to be inside the stall/behind the counter.  Anyone seen to be misusing the equipment should be asked to leave. | Low | Yes |

| Operation of equipment on site | Operator, spectator, participants | Injury to operator, spectators or participants. | Low | Spectators not allowed in the operational area whilst someone is participating. Spectators to be kept at a distance from the equipment and not allowed to stand/rest against, or interfere with the equipment in any way. Balls etc, only to be used on the equipment provided and placed back on equipment after use. | Low | Yes |

| User safety                    | Spectator, participants           | Injury to spectators or participants.           | Low | Should any participant appear to be under the influence of alcohol/drugs to the extent where they are posing a risk to themselves or other people, the equipment should be closed and assistance requested from the event manager. Children to be supervised by an adult at all times.                                 | Low | Yes |

| Pre-existing conditions | Participants                            | Injury to operator, spectators or participants.     | Medium | Participants should be aware of their own ability and make a personal choice whether to take part. Anyone suffering from pre-existing conditions, such as physical mobility restrictions, broken bones etc should not take part in this actiity. | Low | Yes |

| Heat                    | Operator,<br>spectator,<br>participants | Injury to operator, spectators or participants.     | Low    | The equipment should not be set up near any sources of heat or naked flames.   | Low | Yes |
| Weather                 | Operator,<br>spectator,<br>participants | Slip/trip or injury from falling/ moving equipment. | Low    | Weather forecasts to be monitored and in cases of high winds / heavy rain etc, JM Entertainment staff are to evaluate and dismantle the equipment if deemed necessary.   | Low | Yes |

# Risk rating

## <u>High</u>

# For example:

- fatality possible to one or more individuals however infrequent
- major injury to few individuals occurring frequently

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likelihood of long term muscular-skeletal problems affecting significant numbers of staff Immediate action required

### Medium

# For example:

- major injury to one/few individuals occurring infrequently
- likelihood of long term muscular-skeletal problems affecting some staff. Requires attention as soon as possible

### Low

## For example:

• minor injury occurring infrequently to few staff. Not a priority, may need attention if not as low as reasonably practicable.
