				Participants are to stay a safe distance away from the plasma screen to avoid striking it during play.		
				Spectators should keep a distance away from the play area and equipment.		

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Pre-existing medical conditions	Participants	Injuries or illness exacerbated by participation.	Medium	Anyone with pre-existing illness or injury that would be affected by play should not take part. Pregnant women should not take part. Anyone who becomes ill whilst playing should stop immediately and seek help.	Low	Yes
Fire	Participants, staff, spectators	Burns	Low	All electrical equipment to be PAT tested. No naked flames or smoking allowed near the equipment.	Low	Yes

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Misuse	Participants	Various injuries	Low	Manufacturer s instructions should be followed at all times. Anyone seen to be misusing equipment should be asked to leave play. Anyone under the influence of too much alcohol or drugs are not allowed to use the equipment. Staff reserve the right to	Low	Yes

Risk rating

High

For example:

- fatality possible to one or more individuals however infrequent
- major injury to few individuals occurring frequently
- likelihood of long term muscular-skeletal problems affecting significant numbers of staff Immediate action required

Medium

For example:

- major injury to one/few individuals occurring infrequently
- likelihood of long term muscular-skeletal problems affecting some staff. Requires attention as soon as possible

Low

For example:

• minor injury occurring infrequently to few staff. Not a priority, may need attention if not as low as reasonably practicable.
