Falls during activity				Participants should be equally matched in height and weight. A floor mat will be provided.

Choking	Participants	Participants could choke on food and drink	Medium	No food or drink to be consumed on ride	Low	Yes
Fire	Participants, spectators and staff	Fire near or around sumo suits could cause them to ignite, injuring participants, staff and spectators	Medium	No smoking or naked flames near the suits	Low	Yes

Over exertion	Participants	Existing medical conditions could be exacerbated during this activity	Medium	Participants with neck issues, heart conditions and people who are feeling unwell should use excessive caution. Pregnant women cannot participate in this activity.	Medium	Yes, supervision by staff or named adult.
Adverse weather conditions	Participants, spectators.	Wind and rain may increase the risk of injury from slips and falls when using the suits.	Medium	This activity should not take place in adverse weather conditions	Low	Yes, weather conditions should be checked prior to the event.

Risk rating

High

For example,

- fatality possible to one or more individuals however infrequent
- major injury to few individuals occurring frequently

likelihood of long term muscular-skeletal problems affecting significant numbers of staff Immediate action required Medium For example,

- major injury to one/few individuals occurring infrequently
- likelihood of long term muscular-skeletal problems affecting some staff. Requires attention as soon as possible Low For example, minor injury occurring infrequently to few staff. Not a priority, may need attention if not as low as reasonably practicable.
