Mechanical or structural failure	Risk of any number of components, including the pulleys, rope, harness, winch etc failing causing injury to ride users	Low	Medium	Ride should be serviced annually and checked before each event. Ride should be operated by trained JM entertainment staff	None	Medium
Structure not on level ground	Risk of injury to participants	Low	Low	Checks to ensure ride is on suitable flat ground	None	Low

Collision of participants	Injuries, such as cuts and bruises, concussion.	Low	Low	Trampolines to be monitored at all times, with only the one child per trampoline allowed.	None	Low
Slips, trips and falls	Risk of physical injury to participants using the ride	Medium	Low	Safety briefing by trained staff to participants on how to take car and be careful on the ride Crash mats around the ride so that if participant is not attached and falls the fall will be cushioned	None	Low
Spectators becoming to close to the ride during use	Risk of injury to members of the public or ride users causing physical injury	Medium	Low	Physical barrier to be erected around the ride during use, preventing people from getting too close	None	Low

Risk assessments should be reviewed annually, after accidents and near misses, which should be reported to operators

Risk rating

High

For example,

- fatality possible to one or more individuals however infrequent
- major injury to few individuals occurring frequently
- likelihood of long term muscular-skeletal problems affecting significant numbers of staff

Immediate action required

Medium

For example,

- major injury to one/few individuals occurring infrequently
- likelihood of long term muscular-skeletal problems affecting some staff.

Requires attention as soon as possible

Low

For example,

• minor injury occurring infrequently to few staff.

Not a priority, may need attention if not as low as reasonably practicable.
