

Inflatable Wind Safety Policy:

At JM Entertainment Ltd, the safety of our customers, guests, staff and the public is our highest priority. All inflatable equipment is operated in line with UK HSE guidance, manufacturer instructions and industry best practice.

Maximum Wind Limit:

Outdoor inflatables **must not be installed, operated, or remain in use when wind gusts exceed 24 mph**, or any lower limit stated by the manufacturer.

If wind conditions become unsafe before or during your event, our team will suspend use, deflate equipment, or cancel installation where necessary.

Weather Monitoring:

We monitor forecasts in the lead-up to every outdoor booking using recognised UK weather services. Final decisions may be made on the day following an on-site safety assessment.

On-Site Safety Checks:

Before installation, our team will assess:

- Wind speed and gusts
- Site exposure (fields, hills, coastal areas etc.)
- Ground suitability for anchoring
- Overall operating safety

If conditions are unsafe, equipment will not be installed.

Customer Guidance:

We strongly recommend customers have a backup plan for outdoor events, such as:

- Indoor venue option
- Alternative entertainment
- Flexibility to postpone

Important Notice:

JM Entertainment Ltd staff will never install or operate equipment where wind conditions present a safety risk. All decisions made by our team in relation to safety are final.
